



“Make It 5!”

Number of Players: 2-4

Materials: Deck of “Make It 5” cards

Objective: The objective is to use four cards to get a sum as close to five as possible.

Set Up: Set aside the *game contents* and *link to directions* cards. Shuffle cards. Deal out four cards to each player. Players put their four cards in a line, face down in front of them. The remaining cards are placed in the center as a draw pile. Turn one card from the draw pile face up to start the discard pile.

Directions:

- The game starts with one player choosing to either take a card from the draw pile, the discard pile, or turning over a card from their lineup.
- If the player chooses a card from the discard pile, they use it to replace any card from their four card lineup (it can be face up or face down cards). The card from the lineup is put on top of the discard pile.
- If the player chooses a card from the draw pile, they have the option to use it to replace a card in their lineup or discard it.
- If the player chooses to turn over a card from their lineup, play rotates to the next player.
- Play continues until one player has all four cards face up. At this time remaining players turn over any face down cards and all players find the sum of their four cards. This concludes the game.
- The player whose sum is closest to 5 wins the round (the sum may exceed 5).
- Shuffle and deal the cards again to play another game.
