



## “Match It 5!”

**Number of Players:** 2-4

**Materials:** Deck of “Match It 5” cards

**Objective:** The objective is to find two cards that have a sum of five.

**Set Up:** Set aside the *game contents* and *link to directions* cards. Shuffle cards. Deal out all cards face down to each player. This is their draw pile.

**Directions:**

- The first player turns up the top card from their draw pile and places face up in the center so it is visible to everyone.
- Player’s alternate turns placing a card face up in the center.
- On their turn, if a player identifies a combination that makes 5, calls out “Match It,” states the combination, and takes the cards that made the match. This begins the pile of winning cards for the player.
- Players can make more than one match, but only when it is their turn.
- If a player calls out an incorrect match, the player that catches the mistake keeps those cards.
- Play continues until all cards from each draw pile have been played. The player with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
